Rear Bumper Mounting Instructions



2	2	HDW1084	6mm x 30mm Hex Bolts
3	2	HDW9012	1/4" Flat Washers
4	2	HDW9064	1 5/8" Endcaps

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Remove the stock bolts holding the back corners of the rear rack to the plastic fenders. Access them from the rear wheel well area (one on each side). See Illustration.
- 2. Open the rear storage compartment and remove the two bolts securing the rear rack supports to the frame. Keep these bolts for reinstallation.
- 3. Position the bumper through the open rear storage compartment lid and hold in place over the rear rack supports. Loosely reinstall the two stock hex bolts through the bumper, rear rack supports, and into the frame.
- 4. Align the two outer bumper support brackets with the rack mounts under the fenders and loosely install two 6mm x 30mm hex bolts and 1/4" flat washers through the bumper support brackets, plastic, and into the rear rack.
- 3. Make sure the bumper is aligned properly with the rear of the machine and tighten all bolts.
- 4. Using a rubber mallet, lightly tap the endcaps into place on the brushguard.

NOTE: This bumper is designed to be used as a brushguard only and should not be used to push heavy objects. Bent or damaged bumpers will not be warranted.
