

109811- EZ Clutch Adjustor Upgrade Kit

1. Locate the clutch cable adjustor on the right side of the frame down tube.



2. Remove the yellow plastic adjustor with a a pair of side cutters. Cut the plastic from the bottom and from the top. Be careful not to cut the cable wire.

4. The photo below shows the parts that you are removing from the stock upper cable.







WARNING: The rider's safety depends upon the correct installation of this kit. Use the appropriate service manual procedures. Test brakes at low speed. If brakes are not operating properly, testing at high speeds can cause loss of control, which could result in death or serious injury.

5. Remove the O-ring from the adjustor. Align the slots on the two parts of the adjustor, then slide the wire into the slot.

6. Now install the o-ring by sliding it over the bottom of the cable and back into the groove on the adjustor.



7. The new adjustor should look like the picture below when installed. After adjusting the clutch, tighten the set screw.



8. In the image below: On the left is the stock cable (before), and on the right is the new adjustor installed (after).
